Christ is calling you, the church needs you, the Pope believes in you and he expects great things of you.

n this Sunday's Gospel passage, the word "abide" appears eight times. The word comes from the old English word 'a-bid', which means: 'await', 'remain', 'lodge', 'sojourn', 'dwell', 'continue' and 'endure.' It also means: "to put with", "to wait patiently", "to remain in place", "to continue to exist", "to conform", "to comply", "to reside", "to remain faithful", "to sustain" and "without yielding".

Every interpretation seems to indicate that the word 'abide' is connected to something that is strong, fixed, firm, enduring, permanent, existing and rooted in place. It cannot be easily moved or shaken. Therefore, when Jesus says "Abide in me", he speaks about a relationship that is bound so tightly, strong and unyielding, that regardless the circumstances and challenges of life, it endures.

It means that if we settle for a superficial relationship with Jesus, in a way, we become less than useful disciples of Jesus. As Jesus says, "Whoever does not abide in me is thrown away like a branch and withers; such branches are gathered and thrown into the fire and burnt." Here, Jesus is referring to the practice of wine-growers who prune or cut off the weaker branches, so that the vine, the most important part of the plant, becomes strong, healthy and productive. In other words, branches with 'weak' connections to the vine are removed.

"What type of relationship do I have with Jesus?" "Is it one that is strong, firm and fixed on him regardless the circumstances of life?" If yes, then God will prune you to become stronger, firmer and more enduring in your discipleship. However, if your relationship is dependent on your emotions, feelings and moods, and you find yourself not trusting him when times are tough, then your discipleship to Jesus may be weak and fragile.

God wants us to become healthy and productive branches, joined closely and firmly with Jesus. We are reminded that it is not enough for us to be a Christian in name only, but that we must 'abide' in Jesus and allow Jesus to 'abide in us'. We have to become so fixed to him that nothing or no one can shake, break or separate us from his everlasting love. So with this reasoning and understanding, "do you truly abide in Jesus"? *
