In one way or
another every one of
us is a prodigal.

Then, in today's gospel, Jesus tells the parable of the Prodigal Son. In one way or another every one of us is a prodigal. Pope Francis, in one of his homilies, touched on this parable. He said so poignantly,

'I think of mothers and fathers in apprehension when they see their children distancing themselves, entering dangerous ways. I think of parish priests and catechists who sometimes wonder if their work was in vain. But I also think of those who are in prison, and who think that their life has ended; of all those who have made bad choices and are unable to look at the future; of all those who hunger for mercy and forgiveness and believe that they do not merit it ... In whatever situation of life, I must not forget that I will never cease to be a child of God, of a Father who loves me and awaits my return. Even in the most awful situation of life, God awaits me, God wants to embrace me.'

Of the older son who had stay put, Pope Francis said, 'Jesus reminds us that one does not remain in the Father's house to have a compensation, but because one has the dignity of being co-responsible children. It is not about "bartering" with God, but about following Jesus who gave Himself on the cross without measure.'

In 2 Corinthian 5:17-21 St Paul tells us that the old things have passed, and new things have come. God has reconciled the world to himself through Christ and entrusting to us the message of reconciliation. How grateful we must be, and how we, the prodigals turn ambassadors for Christ, must now go about the ministry of reconciliation.

Intriguingly Jesus in narrating the *Prodigal Son* omitted the final response of the elder son. If we identify ourselves with this personality, do we not for a moment think the Lord is asking us to open our hearts to be 'merciful like the Father?'
